

Privacy Notice

Your Personal Data

EACS 2018 will be what's known as the 'Data Controller' of your personal data processed in relation to the 22nd Biennial Conference (to be held between Wednesday 29 August and Saturday 1 September) for the purpose of being used to promote EACS and document the 22nd Biennial Conference. This Privacy Notice will explain how EACS 2018 will process your personal data.

Why we need it

We are collecting your basic personal data (in the form of photographic images) in order to document EACS 2018. We will only collect data that we need in order to fulfil and oversee this.

Legal basis for processing your data

We must have a legal basis for processing all personal data. In this instance, the legal basis is 'Consent'.

What we do with it and who we share it with

The photographs taken will be processed by EACS 2018 Conference staff, EACS staff, and Chiang Ching-kuo Foundation staff for use on their respective websites.

How long do we keep it for?

Your data will be retained by EACS for up to three years. After this time, data will be securely deleted. However, some images may be kept permanently once they are published and be kept as an archive of EACS' events.

What are your rights?

You can request access to the information we process about you at any time. If at any point you believe that the information we process relating to you is incorrect, you can request to see this information and may in some instances request to have it restricted, corrected or, erased. You may also have the right to object to the processing of data and the right to data portability.

As we are using 'Consent' as the legal basis to process your personal data, you also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.
